

## **Carthage Architecture/Residential Trunk Table of Contents**

**Architeacher** - lesson plans on how to take a walking field trip and how to set up a bulletin board and or activity center (all grade levels). Materials available in trunk for display.

**Architecture** – lesson plans: “Bag Buildings” (K-3) “Think Like A Tourist”(5-12)

**House Detective** -- how to research where you live and finding history in your home (upper grades)

**Victorian Arkansans - How They Loved, Played and Worked:** Good vocabulary list, pictures of home styles, 3 art activities, word search puzzle and discussion questions and topics (upper grades)

**Victorian House: Identification and Conservation** – pictures and text of slide show which is available at Carthage Public Library (upper grades)

**Patterns that Thump, Bump and Jump** – lesson plans and ideas to adapt to field trip or walking tour, reading fairy tales to look for patterns and then learning about patterns in buildings with shapes, etc. (K-3). Also ideas for art projects (K-6).

**Main Street Carthage Coloring Book** – coloring and identifying homes and buildings (K-3)

**Architectural Elements Give a Place Its Own Unique Character** – Lesson plans looking at pictures of buildings as well as tactile exercises where students identify building materials. Worksheet for neighborhood walking tour (5-8).

**Buildings in Children’s Books** - ideas for lessons including future planning and making a skyline of black paper. List of children’s books that emphasize buildings and architecture (4-8).
